White Wines

1. Aromo Sauvignon Blanc, Chile

Easy drinking, refreshing & crisp with hints of tropical fruit.

2. Aloe Tree Chenin Blanc, South Africa

Subtle yet full with ripe apple & honey characters.

3. One Chain Chardonnay, Australia

Crisp, lively & bright, citrus scented & tangy. Well balanced, with ripe pear & vanilla notes.

4. Pinot Grigio, Italy

Dry fresh & fruity, low on acidity. A very good all-rounder.

5. Rioja Blanco, Finca Manzanos, Spain

This is a delightful rich wine with hints of almond & apple blossom.

6. Muscadet, France

Fine, fresh, clean delicate & a delicious fruity but crisp finish.

7. Macon Villages, France

Briefly aged in oak, this excellent vintage has a lovely roundness & soft dry finish.

8. Te Merio, Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand

Lime & Gooseberry aromas, with a palate of tropical fruits, well balanced.

9. Gavi di Gavi, Italy

Delicate middleweight wine with floral notes & a delightful finish.

10. Chablis, Domaine Seguinot, France

A magnificent wine from a marvelous year, surprised by its fullness & persistent finish.

11. Sancerre Domaine Picard, France

Pale & golden with green tinges reflects a mineral fruity nose, good body & a crisp finish.

12. Pouilly Fuisse, Domaine Les Vieux Murs, France

Smooth slightly creamy wine, fine elegant flavours, typical Fuisse.

Champagne & Sparkling

13. Prosecco, Italy

Lightly Sparkling Italian wine. The classic that everyone knows. Dry & Crisp.

14. Etienne Oudart Champagne, France

Generous aromas of Pistacio, Almonds, Lime. Dry clean & refreshing.

Dessert Wines

15. Domaine des Baumard, France, 500ml

Possibly the one of the best sweet wine from France it is richly concentrated with dried fruits.

16. Aromo Merlot, Chile

Ripe berry fruit with a mellow lingering finish.

17. Maison de Vigneron Rouge, France

Beautiful soft & succulent red with ripe red fruit & little hint of spice.

18. Aloe Tree Shiraz, South Africa

Blackcurrant & Cherry fruits perfectly integrated to become a velvet smooth textured wine.

19. Vega Piedra Rioja Tinto, Spain

Light fruity taste of violets & spice. The soft tannins give a pleasant long smooth finish.

20. Calusari, Pinot Noir, Romania

Soft & juicy with a bags of red berry fruit & hints of vanilla.

21. One Chain Shiraz Cabernet Sauvignon, Australia

A medium bodied wine with hints of spice combining with fresh berry fruits.

22. Les Coteaux, Cotes de Rhone Villages, France

Grapes from young vines, gives you a lovely luscious claret with delicious hints of blackcurrant & bramble.

23. Man Meets Mountain, Malbec, Argentina

Good rich colour, spicy fresh nose with lovely clean fruit. Touch of plum & great length.

24. Sherwood Estate Pinot Noir, New Zealand

With a nose of cherry & plum, a clean soft fruit taste this is the epitome of a well-structured Pinot Noir.

25. Domaine Berrod, Fleurie, France

One of the top producers in this famous village. The nose is filled with blackberries & spice, on the palate has wild berries, particularly raspberries, the finish is soft & persistent.

26. Chianti Classico, Greggiano Pontignano, Italy

Rich in flavor, full bodied & big fruit flavor with hints of vanilla & red berries.

27. Rully Premier Cru, France

Rich with an irresistible up front charm added to complexity, & mineral finish.

28. Chateau Garraud, Lalande de Pomerol, France

Violets, ripe plum, cedar wood, spiciness. This is a big dark rich wine, but lots of fruitiness.

Rose

29. Prosecco Rose, Italy

Lightly Sparkling Pink Wine. Dry & Crisp.

30. Bella Modella, Pinot Grigio, Italy

Easy drinking lovely summer Rose. Very light to look at. Dry yet fruity.

31. Domaine De Mont-Auriol, France

Languedoc, premium, elegant, fruity, crisp

32. Sancerre Rose, France

Soft light fruits with wings of sweetness & a dryish finish.
